
# **Proposition 2: Eligibility Requirements**

- The facility must be in a municipality that passed the tax relief such as the City of Dallas and Dallas County.
- The property must be operating as a qualifying child-care facility.
- The facility must be participating in the Texas Rising Star program.
- At least 20% of enrollment in the facility must be children on TWC scholarships.
- The facility must be licensed by the Health and Human services Commission to provide care, training, supervision, education, assessment, or treatment for a child not related by blood, marriage, or adoption to the owner or operator of the facility.
- The property must be used exclusively to provide developmental and educational services for children.
- An exemption cannot be claimed for property for which the person claims an exemption under §11.13 (homestead).

- Once the child-care exemption is granted, an application does not need to be filed annually unless the property's ownership changes or qualifications for the exemption change.



# **Proposition 2: How to Apply**

#### **DOCUMENTATION:**

Applicants must include the following documents with the application:

- Documentation that the child-care facility participates in the Texas Workforce Commission's Texas Rising Star Program -
  - Use a picture of your TRS star level certificate or if entry level, your provider agreement
- Documentation showing that at least 20 percent of children enrolled in the child-care facility receive subsidized child-care services provided through the childcare services program administered by the Texas Workforce Commission.
  - Log into the attendance system and screen shot or take a picture of the list of children receiving subsidies
  - Submit your current total enrollment and/or class rosters

 For a property owner leasing the property to a qualifying child-care facility, Form 50-845, Child-Care Facility Exemption Affidavit certifying that the property owner has provided to the child-care facility a disclosure.



## Prop 2 tax exemption

- The chief appraiser may request additional information to evaluate this application.
- Property owner must comply within 30 days of the request or the application will be denied.
- The chief appraiser may extend this deadline for a single period not to exceed 15 days for good cause shown.
